

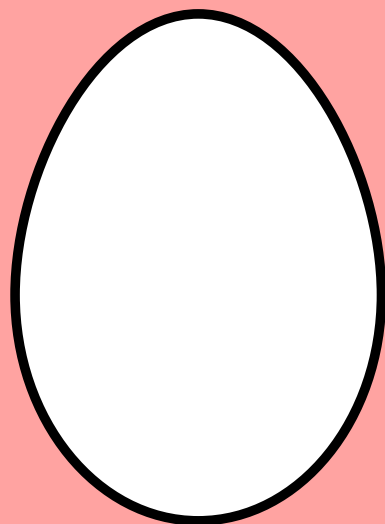
Celebrating Easter with creative activities

Creative Zone: Design your own Easter Egg

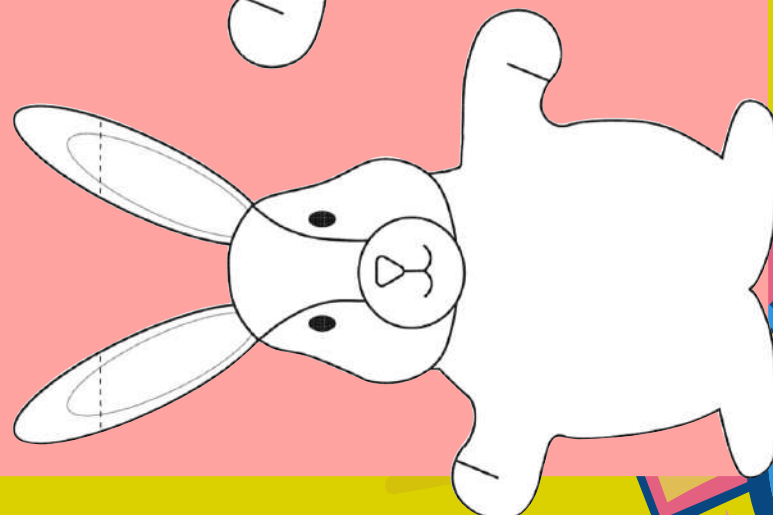
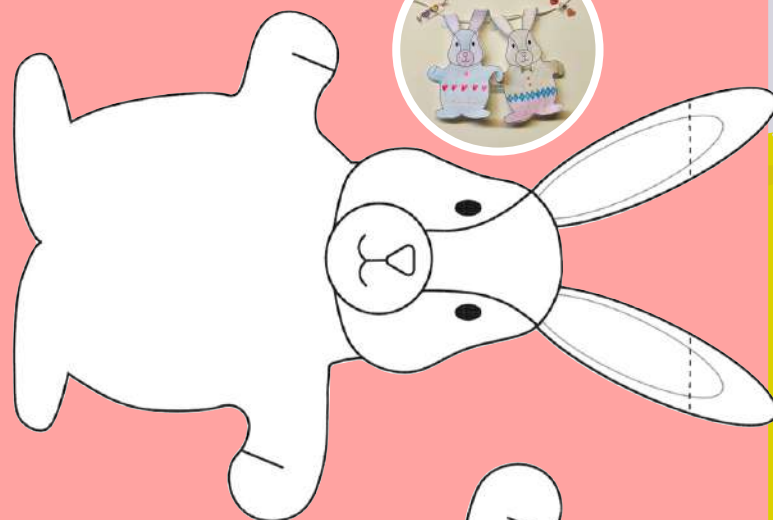
How does your ideal Easter egg look like?

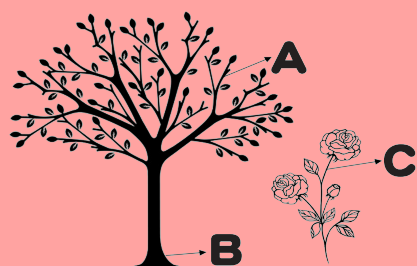

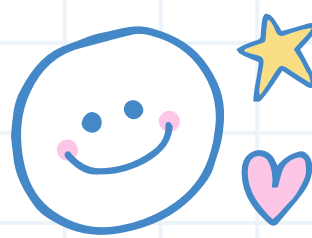
Fostering Multi-Intelligence in a Serene English Environment

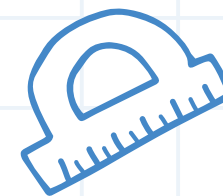
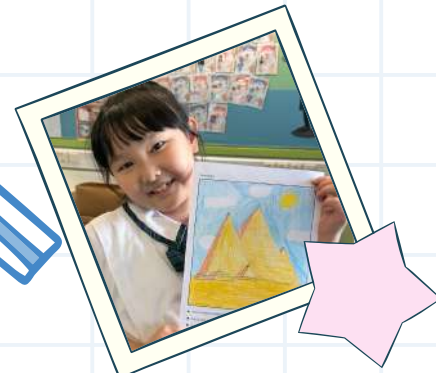
Chinese Festivals
